**Online nominations for all awards are due by September 24, 2021.** All faculty, staff, and students are encouraged to nominate faculty members for these awards.

**Nominators are asked to submit the online nomination form, a copy of the nominee's curriculum vitae, and a narrative of 1000 words or less, stating why the nominee meets the award criteria and is deserving of the award.** Please do not submit additional information during the initial phase. At a later date, the nominator(s) may be asked to provide additional supporting information, such as additional letters of support, upon request from the selection committees. Because of the competitive nature of these awards, resubmission of a previously unsuccessful nomination is encouraged. To improve the chances for success, nominators may contact the chair of the selection committee to determine why the previous nomination was unsuccessful. Awards will be presented at Showcase during the spring semester.
